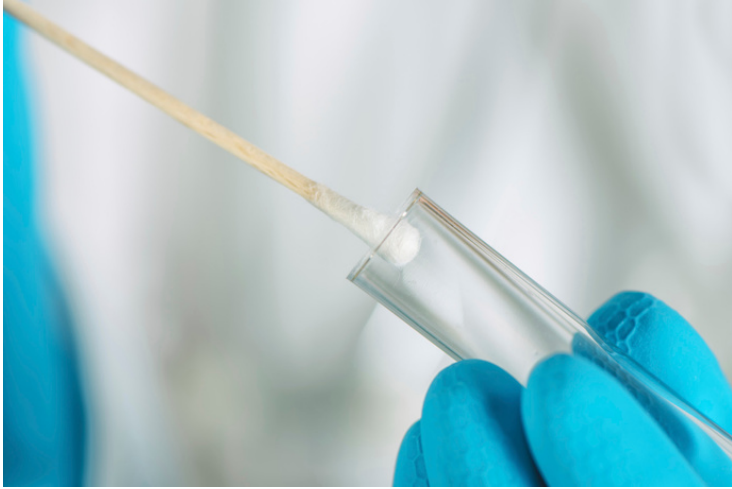

## **CHAUFFEURS ARE COVID-19 RAPID TESTED, DECONTAMINATED AND PRESCREENED**



When requested, chauffeurs can be Covid-19 rapid tested prior to a pickup for ultimate peace-of-mind. Rapid testing is available in New York, Los Angeles and Atlanta. A \$65.00 fee will apply per rapid test.



Decontamination booths are used in company-owned cities to disinfect chauffeurs with ionized salt water before their shift begins and when it ends.



Chauffeurs are assessed for fever, cough and shortness of breath prior to beginning their shift and monitored in between rides via survey.

## **VEHICLES ARE SANITIZED MULTIPLE TIMES DAILY AND CHAUFFEURS WEAR PPE.**

Vehicles are sprayed with Electrostatic Devices filled with Vital Oxide after every shift change.



Chauffeurs sanitize vehicles not only in-between rides, but also whenever the passenger gets out of the vehicle.



Chauffeurs wear a face mask and latex gloves. Vehicles have an HEPA ionizer installed to clean in cabin air. The vehicles ventilation system will be used to bring in fresh air and windows will be cracked open.



# **BLS DUTY OF HEALTH AND SAFETY**

## **IN-VEHICLE DIVIDERS ARE INSTALLED AND PHYSICAL DISTANCING PROTOCOLS ARE IMPLEMENTED.**



In-vehicle dividers are recommended by the CDC, made of shatterproof polycarbonate and have been designed to not interfere with the safety of the vehicle.



Luggage will only be handled upon the passengers requests. All items have been removed from the backseat of the vehicle.



In sedans, passengers should ride behind the passenger seat. For SUVs, it's recommended passengers sit in the 3rd row when available. Sprinters and coaches should only be filled to 50% occupancy.

*In the event of a positive covid-19 test result from a BLS employee, affiliate or passenger, a complete contact tracing protocol will be implemented.*
